

MOPIX

- Mopix uses the Rear Window[®] Captioning System which displays text on a display which is mounted in the rear of a theater. The panels are attached to the seat and are portable and adjustable, enabling the caption user to sit anywhere in the theater.
- MoPix also provides DVS (Descriptive Video Service) which delivers descriptive narration via infrared or FM listening systems, enabling the user to hear the descriptive narration on headsets without disturbing other audience members. The descriptions provide narrated information about key visual elements such as actions, settings, and scene changes.



Descriptive Video Service

- Provides descriptive narration of key visual elements for television programs, feature films, DVDs and other forms of media.
- Key visual elements include the characters' actions, costumes, facial expressions, as well as scene changes and on-screen text.
- Narration of these elements is carefully woven into the soundtrack of the program or film, creating a seamless mix of program audio and descriptive narration.



Closed Captioning

- Displays text on a television, video screen or other visual display to provide additional or interpretive information.
- Typically shows a transcription of the audio portion of a program as it occurs (either verbatim or in edited form), sometimes including non-speech elements.
